Subject: ZEISS PERSONNEL - HEIDENHEIM.

Reference your BIOS/MOV/167/4 dated 28 March.

1. We would refer you to our letter IN FIAT EP.254-84 dated 24 January 1947 which enclosed copies of two letters received from U.S. Mil. Gov. Wurttemberg-Baden, stating why certain Zeiss personnel could not be evacuated to U.K. for interrogation.
2. These letters explained in fair detail the aims of the Zeiss organisation at Heidenheim, its planned monthly production figures, etc.
3. If further information is required it is felt that a request for interrogation of Zeiss personnel "in situ" by a representative of M. of S. would receive the approval of the Office of the Director of Intelligence, EUCOM. In this way all information may be obtained.

2. May this Secretariat please be informed whether your office is likely to be able to obtain this information, if not whether you see any other way other channel by which it might be obtained.
