Summary:

A copy of "What Are Song Shuo, Lu Ping, and Peng Peiyun Really Doing in the Cultural Revolution?" with handwritten Albanian-language notation. This poster, placed at Beijing University on 25 May 1966 by a group associated with the academic and activist Nie Yuanzi, was aimed at three administrators.
