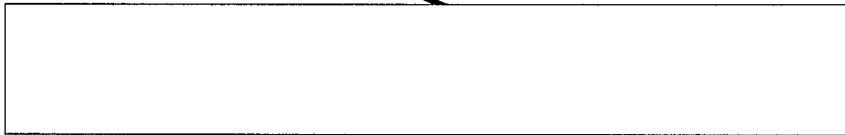

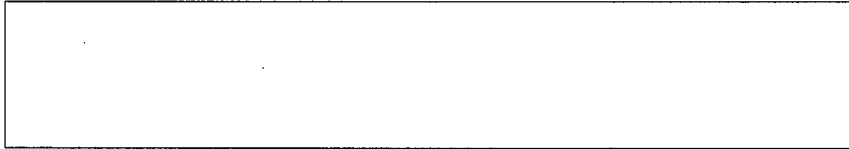

Major General Miroslaw MILEWSKI will present the report;

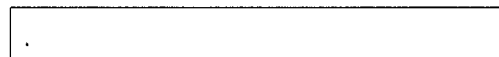
