I am very pleased to extend my invitation to you to visit Israel with your wife at a mutually convenient time in the next future.

I suggest to extend my next visit to R.S.A. on mid March 1982 and I hope that on this occasion we shall be able to sign the "Memorandum of Understanding on fields of Strategic Cooperation".

I am pleased to attach here the new draft which is based on our discussions together.

Furthermore I authorized already General Raphael Eitan, the Chief of General Staff to pay a visit to your country on mid February 1982.
