I am sending you a letter from General McGaw to his Excellency.

Action has been taken to install the telephone in the Bando Hotel to meet imminent requirement. I was told that installation will be completed within today.

The ceremony yesterday at Seoul Stadium was very impressive. General Hull was about to weep when troop started to make final pass before him.

General and Mrs. Hull received three packages from President and Madame Rhee.

General Taylor is coming back here the morning of the 26th of March to observe President Rhee's Birthday Party at Army Commander's Mess, Yongsan. The dinner begins at 1900 hours.

I hope you come with President Rhee's party and have birthday dinner with us in the aides room, if you can.
