

Vassiliev Notebooks file guide

When composing his notebooks Alexander Vassiliev preceded each section with the KGB archival file number, volume number, and a title or brief description of the subject matter of the file from which he was extracting or summarizing material. Below is an guide where notebook pages are linked to the file from which the notebook content was derived. For example, the material on page 45 of the *Black Notebook* was drawn from documents in KGB archival file 43173, volume 1, an Organizational and Operational file of the United States. Material on page 134 of *White Notebook #1* was drawn from file 24957, volume 1, a personal file for KGB officer Vasily Zarubin.
