SUMMARY: DANISH MEDIA CONTINUED TO DEVOTE PRIME SPACE TO THE NORTH KOREAN DIPLOMATIC SCANDAL. ATTENTION TODAY (OCTOBER 20) WAS DEVOTED TO STORIES ON ACTIONS TAKEN BY THE POLICE IN SWEDEN AND FINLAND WHICH ARE BEING INTERPRETED AS PROOF OF SIMILAR ILLEGAL NORTH KOREAN ACTIVITY IN THOSE COUNTRIES. SPECULATION CONTINUES ON HOW THE PROFITS FROM THE ILLICIT ACTIVITIES WERE USED AND FEATURE ARTICLES DISCUSS NORTH KOREAN DEBT DEFAULTS AND NORTH KOREA AS A REFUGE FOR TERRORISTS. DANISH FOREIGN MINISTER NOW STATES THAT HE BELIEVES THE CRIMES WERE NOT COMMITTED FOR THE PERSONAL ADVANTAGE OF THE DIPLOMATS; HE EXPECTS REPLACEMENTS TO STAFF THE EMBASSY TO ARRIVE SOON AND CONTINUES TO EXCLUDE A BREAK IN RELATIONS. END SUMMARY.

1. ALL PAPERS REPORT THE ACTIVITIES OF THE POLICE IN SWEDEN AND FINLAND AND CONCLUDE THAT IN THOSE COUNTRIES TOO THE NORTH KOREANS HAD ABUSED THEIR DIPLOMATIC STATUS. AKTUEL (SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC) REPORTS THAT THE NORTH KOREAN AMBASSADOR IN STOCKHOLM DENIED TO THE PRESS THEIR HAVING DONE ANYTHING WRONG. THE PAPER COMMENTED THAT THE AMBASSADOR DID NOT REFER TO HIS PRIOR EXPULSION FROM NORWAY IN THE CONVERSATION WITH THE SWEDISH PRESS REPRESENTATIVES.

2. AKTUEL ALSO CARRIED AN INTERVIEW WITH A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DANISH-NORTH KOREAN FRIENDSHIP SOCIETY WHO REVEALED THAT ALTHOUGH THE NAME OF SOCIETY HAD BEEN USED AS PUBLISHER ON A VAST ARRAY OF POSH BOOKS (MOSTLY EXALTING KIM IL SUNG) PUT OUT BY EMBASSY, THE SOCIETY WAS NOT RESPONSIBLE. "WE DON'T HAVE THAT KIND OF MONEY", THE SPOKESMAN IS REPORTED TO HAVE SAID.

3. BERLINGSKE TIDENDE (INDEPENDENT CONSERVATIVE) FRONT-PAGED A SPECULATIVE ARTICLE ON HOW NORTH KOREANS USED PROFITS AND FROM TRADE IN NARCOTICS, LIQUOR AND CIGARETTES. THE AUTHOR ASSERTED THAT THE PROCEEDS WERE USED TO TRAIN AND EQUIP MORE THAN 5000 TERRORISTS WHO HAD FOUND REFUGE IN NORTH KOREA IN THE LAST FEW YEARS. LIKE LIBYA, THE ARTICLE SAID, NORTH KOREA HAS BEEN GUILTY OF ORGANIZING A LONG SERIES OF INTERNATIONAL TERRORIST ACTIVITIES IN UNCLASSIFIED

THE FAR EAST AND EUROPE, INCLUDING HIJACKINGS AND ASSASSINATION ATTEMPTS.

4. THE PROBLEMS OF THE DANISH COMPANIES SABROE AND DANNEBROG IN COLLECTING DEBTS OWED BY NORTH KOREA WERE DISCUSSED IN THE WIDER CONTEXT OF OVERALL NORTH KOREAN INDEBTEDNESS. POLITIKEN (INDEPENDENT LEFT-OF-CENTER)

STATES THAT NORTH KOREAN FOREIGN DEBT IS BETWEEN \$1,200 MILLIONS AND \$2,000 MILLIONS. THE FEATURE ARTICLE CONCLUDES THAT IN THESE CIRCUMSTANCES IT IS NOT SURPRISING THAT THE NORTH KOREAN GOVERNMENT PUTS ITS DIPLOMATS TO WORK TO HELP PAY EXPENSES.

5. MIN AVISEN (THE DAILY OF THE "NATIONAL" COMMUNIST, SOCIALIST PEOPLE'S PARTY) EDITORIALIZED ON THE POLITICAL ASPECTS OF NORTH KOREANS' CRIMES NOTING THAT ALTHOUGH "SITUATION IN SOUTHEAST ASIA" (READ US IMPERIALISM) WAS NOT CHANGED ONE IOTA BY THE NORTH KOREAN AMBASSADOR'S BEHAVIOR IN DENMARK, GREATER DIFFICULTY WOULD BE ENCOUNTERED IN TRYING TO PERSUADE OTHERS OF "THE MAGNIFICENCE AND STRENGTH OF NORTH KOREAN STATE".

6. THE PRESS APPEARS GENERALLY UNINFORMED REGARDING THE PRESENT ACTIVITIES OF THE EXPELLED DIPLOMATS. THERE ARE SOME REPORTS OF THE DEPARTURE OF TWO AND THE ARRIVAL OF TWO NEW ONES. INFORMATION (LEFTIST INTELLECTUAL) CARRIES A STATEMENT BY FOREIGN MINISTER K.B. ANDERSEN IN WHICH HE DENIES KNOWLEDGE OF THE ARRIVAL OF NEW PERSONNEL TO MAN THE NORTH KOREAN EMBASSY. POLITIKEN REPORTS THAV EMBASSY PERSONNEL, APPARENTLY FED UP WITH ATTENTION FROM THE PRESS, HAVE MOUNTED A LOUDSPEAKER OUTSIDE THE CHANCERY THROUGH WHICH LOUD NORTH KOREAN MUSIC IS TRANSMITTED IN AN EFFORT TO DROWN OUT THE BARRAGE OF PRESS INQUIRIES.

7. FOREIGN MINISTER ANDERSEN, IN PRESS INTERVIEW AND ON TELEVISION, STATED THAT IN THE LIGHT OF THE IMPLICATION OF NORTH KOREANS IN OTHER COUNTRIES IN ILLEGAL TRAFFICKING IT IS HARD TO BELIEVE THAT THEY ACTED IN A PERSONAL CAPACITY. HE DOUBTED THEY WOULD BE PUNISHED ON RETURN HOME. PRIME MINISTER ANKER JORGENSEN IS QUOTED UNCLASSIFIED
